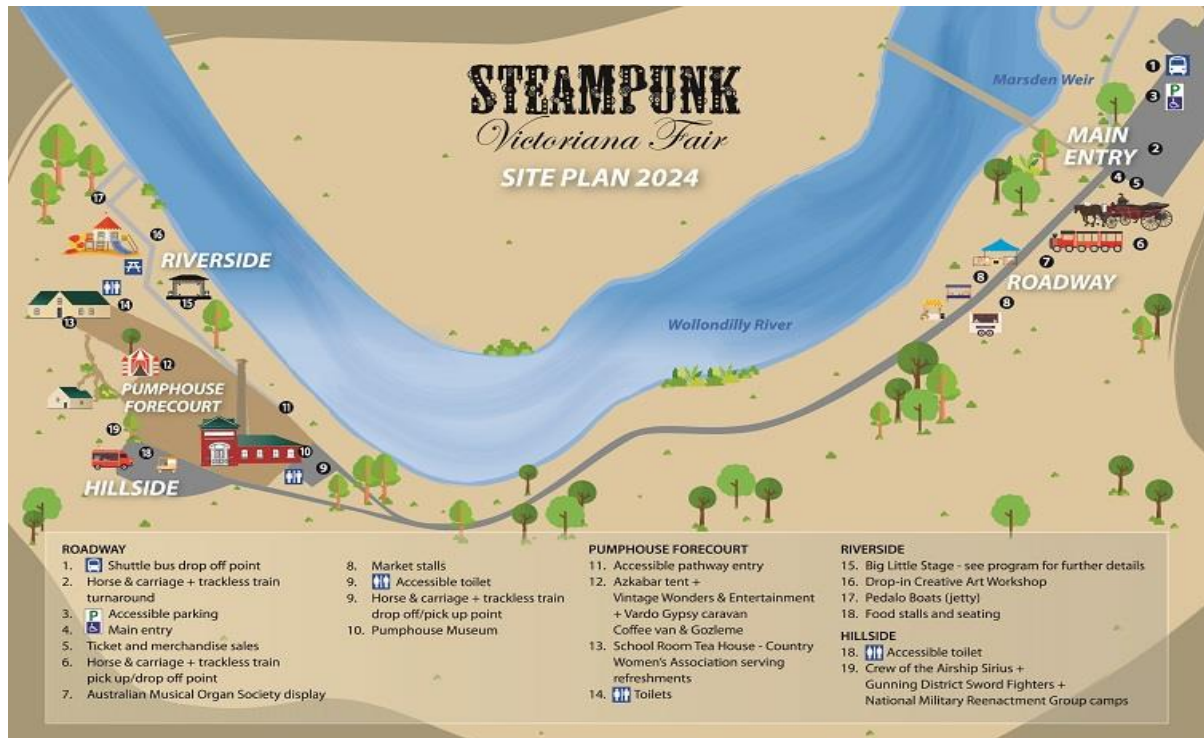


GOULBURN RALLY

18-20 OCTOBER 2024

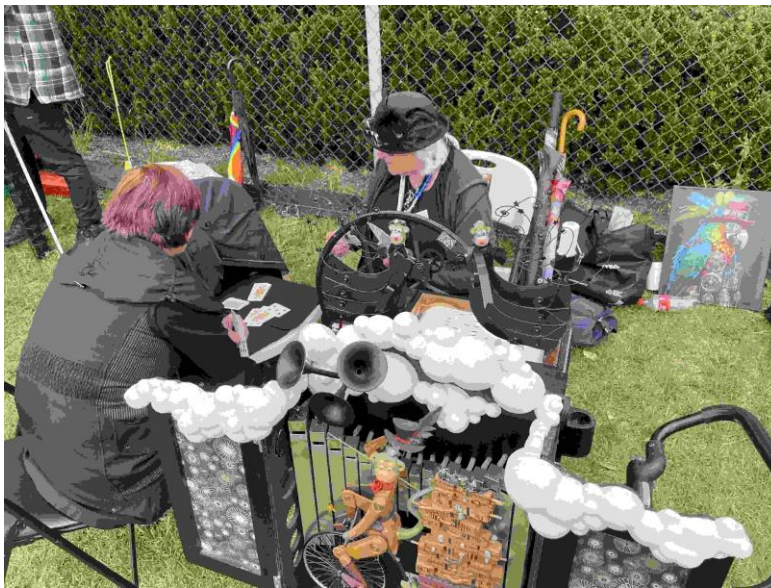

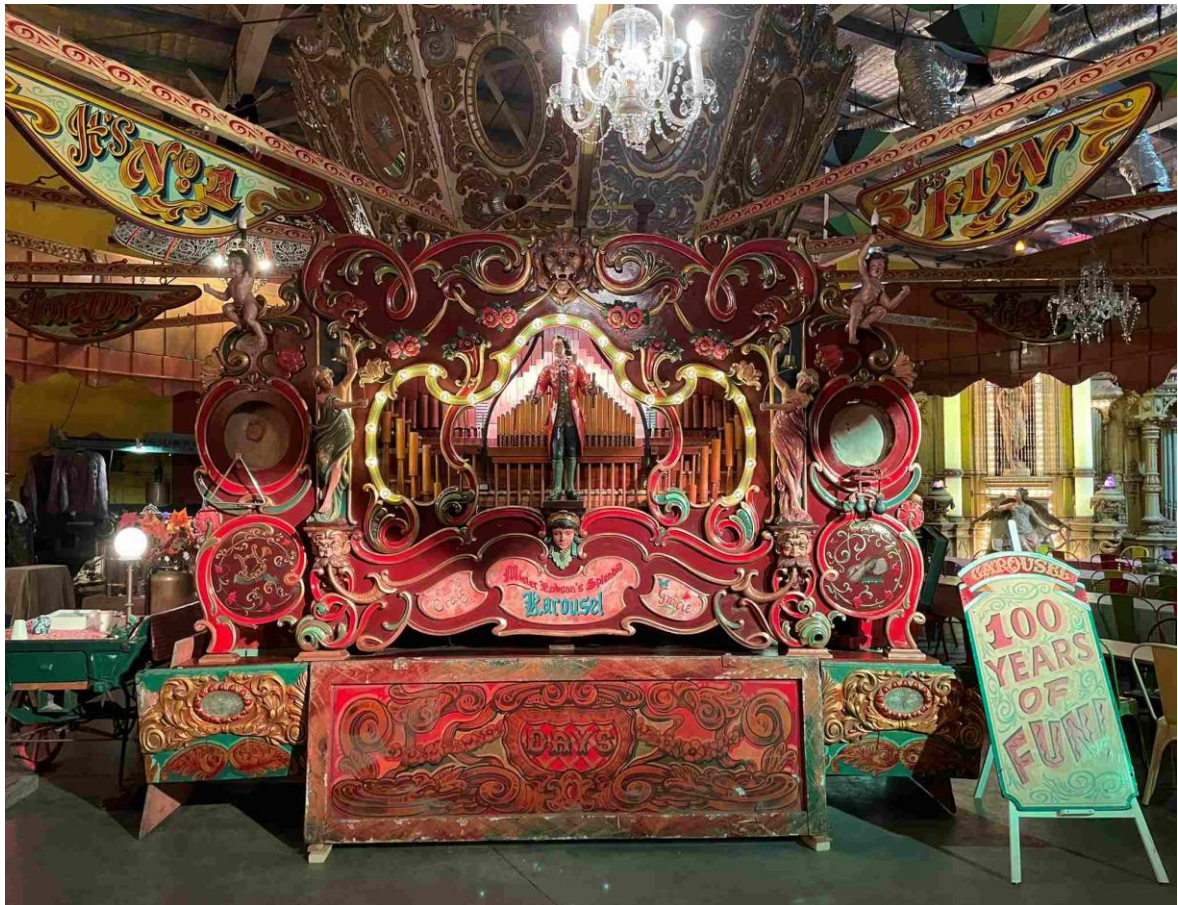
This Ruth organ is in the "Rolls-Royce" category when it comes to mechanical organs
